## New Order for Dansk Retursystem A/S, Denmark

We are proud to announce that Dansk Retursystem A/S, the Danish Scheme operator for beverage containers with deposit, has ordered ten new HLZ® machines to equip five new bottle deposit centers (Pantstation) in Denmark.

The new bottle deposit centers will be added to the fourteen sites already operational in Denmark and will strengthen Dansk Retursystem A/S' collection network by getting even closer to beverage consumers across the country. Our cooperation with Dansk Retursystem A/S supports Anker Andersen's continued commitment to providing innovative solutions for recycling contributing to a more sustainable future.

The Dutch company Techno Trend delivered a new counting center to Plus Retail B.V. in Deventer in September 2024. This facility is equipped with three Anker Andersen HLZ® counting machines, with the option to expand to five HLZ® machines.

At the beginning of October, Techno Trend will start building a second counting center for Plus Retail B.V., located in Oss. In this fully mechanized distribution center, a counting operation is built on a mezzanine floor. In the initial phase, the counting operation will be started with four Anker Andersen HLZ® counting machines with an option to expand the counting operation to six HLZ® machines. Once both locations are up and running, they will collectively process 280 million used beverage packages annually.
