The national Deposit Return System (DRS) in Romania is entering a new development phase as RetuRO, the company responsible for managing DRS in Romania, signed the equipment acquisition agreement with Anker Andersen A/S.

During the initial phase, The Deposit Return System will run with 17 centers nationwide, gradually opened and equipped by the middle of next year, where RetuRO will transport beverage packaging collected from over 80,000 retailers and count and sort them for resale to recycling companies. These machines will handle glass, PET, and aluminum containers and rejecting items outside the DRS scope. As the scheme expands to 17 sites, Anker Andersen A/S will directly supply 94 of these counting machines and oversee the manufacturing and distribution of all other necessary equipment for comprehensive scheme functionality.
